I have included the pre-enrollment forms for our CURRENT students. You can fill out these forms and mail them back to the school at the address listed on the top of this letter. If you would rather you may also wait until we get the all clear to be back in the buildings to drop them off. I will say that we cannot put your student into a classroom for next year until we have that enrollment paperwork back.
